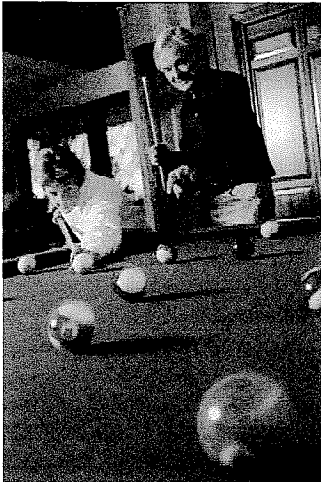


## Hendricks Raises almost \$10K for ATLA during Pool Tournament



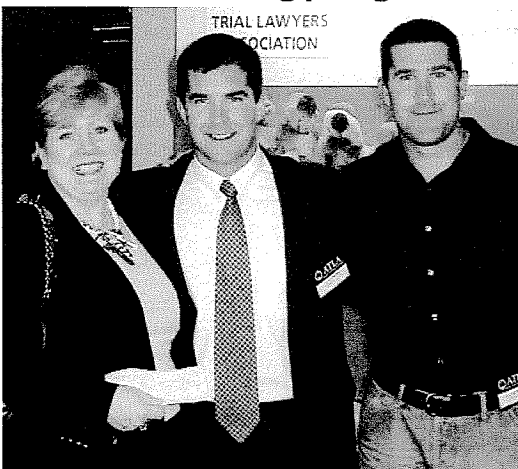
mediate Past President Brad Hendricks was the host of a party and pool tournament on Friday, April 29th at the Basin Park hotel in Eureka Springs.
